**November 2011** ENA Board authorizes development of neighborhood land use goals and action plan.

**November 2012** ENA Neighborhood-wide Workshop to discuss draft land use goals and plan district implementation options.

**November 2015** ENA Board affirms decision to pursue historic district designation. Fall ENA Newsletter Land Use report on the potential for becoming an historic district.

<b>January 2016</b>	Neighborhood Board Meeting discussing the process and attributes of becoming an historic district.
<b>February 2016</b>	ENA Scope and consultant qualification interviews. ENA Newsletter cover story on the process leading to the Board decision to pursue Historic District status.
<b>March 2016</b>	ENA Board Meeting – Presentations by three consultant candidates regarding qualifications, opportunities and challenges of being an historic district, and process as outlined in submitted consultant proposals.
<b>April 2016</b>	Evaluation of interviews and proposals leading to ENA Board Approval of historic district consultant agreement.
<b>April 2016</b>	ENA attends “Historic Districts - Lessons Learned” workshop hosted by Restore Oregon
<b>April 2016</b>	Landmarks Commission briefing of purpose, process, and progress.
<b>May 2016</b>	Historic District Neighborhood Workshop to inform, educate and engage the neighborhood. ENA Board go/no-go decision.
<b>Summer 2016</b>	Volunteer-led (trained and overseen by AECOM) RLS and ILS within study area
<b>October 2016</b>	Neighborhood Workshop review of Survey and Draft Nomination, discussion of draft Design Guidelines.
<b>November 2016</b>	Submit formal Draft Nomination to SHPO
<b>February 2017</b>	Final Pre-submittal Neighborhood workshop
<b>May 2017</b>	SHPO submits application to NPS
<b>December 2017</b>	Historic District Designation Approval, Design Guidelines approval.
